Position: Senior and Junior Non-Key Experts – multiple positions

Project Title: Technical assistance for the support programme to the implementation of EU–Papua New Guinea cooperation

Location: Port Moresby – Papua New Guinea

Job description

The technical assistance will support the work of the NAO-Support Unit, which is responsible for the implementation of current and future EDF programmes, and the Department of National Planning and Monitoring (DNPM), which, inter alia, is responsible for official development assistance and aid effectiveness, and for development of national policies.

The technical assistance contract will provide long-term expertise and a pool of short-term (junior and senior) experts to assist the NAO-SU and the DNPM.

The profiles of the non-key experts for this contract includes, as follows:

- Finance and contracts expert with very good knowledge of EU procedures and experience in a senior administrative and/or finance position in an institution,
- Information technology (with strengths in design and implementation of databases, developing on-line access software),
- Policy analysis and formulation in a range of policy areas, particularly related to health, education, infrastructure, agriculture, rural development and food security,
- Localisation of Agenda 2030 and Sustainable Development goals,
- Development cooperation analysis and report writing,
- Budget support needs analysis (for areas other than public finance),
- Public sector investment programmes (operations and guidelines).

Qualifications and skills

All non-key experts are expected to have:

- fluency in written and spoken English;
- good interpersonal and presentation skills;
- *Senior non-key Experts* are required to have a minimum of a Master's degree plus 10 years' post bachelor's degree experience in the respective field. In lieu of a Master's degree, the candidate may possess a bachelor's degree with a minimum of 15 years directly related experience after achieving the bachelor's degree.
- *Junior non-key experts* are required to have a minimum of a bachelor's degree and 5 years' experience in the respective field and experience of working in Papua New Guinea.
